

Scholarship Fund/Music Grant Applicant Criteria and Information

- The scholarship fund and music grants are designed to fund a learning experience.
- Preference will be given to F.A.M.E members. Member activity level will also be part of the consideration.
- The applicant must use the scholarship fund or music grant for an activity or project that meets the goals of F.A.M.E.
- The applicant must provide the following:
 - The completed scholarship fund/music grant application.
 - An interview; audio, video or personal, explaining the project, how it will help the applicant in light of the goals of F.A.M.E. and how the applicant will use the skills/information learned to benefit the acoustic music community.
- The recipient of the scholarship fund/music grant must return to give a workshop related to their project.
- The recipient must give a report at the F.A.M.E. annual meeting (written or oral).
- Deadline for filing is March 31st.
- The Scholarship Committee will make their decision by April 30th.

Scholarship Fund/Music Grant Awards

The awarding of the scholarship fund/ music grant will take place In May at the F.A.M.E. Annual Concert, exact date will be announced. The recipient may perform at this event. This scholarship fund/music grant is a one-time award. There is no financial, age or gender constraint for the scholarship fund/music grant recipient.

- Applications are available February 15th.
- Completed applications, with all necessary attachments, including project video or audio to be returned to F.A.M.E. in person or by mail, March 31st.
- The award(s) will be announced April 30th.
- Award ceremony will take place in May.
